Project Summary

MHES completed work on various environmental aspects relating to upgrading a former Girl Scout Camp to a camp for disadvantaged youth.

As part of the upgrading of the facility, MHES provided wetland delineation for the 118 acre facility, coordination with permitting agencies, as well as permitting for minor impacts.

A ground water study and pre-drilling plan were prepared for the camp to upgrade potable water supplies for future camp needs.. The ground water project consisted of permitting, drilling, pump testing and reporting of the ground water project.

A Phase I environmental site assessment was also conducted for the camp property.
